Rishikesh



Lakshman Jhula



Lakshman Jhula is a famous iron suspension bridge over the holy Ganges in Rishikesh. Stretching about 450 feet, it connects the Pauri and Tehri districts on either side of the river. According to legend, Lord Rama's younger brother Lakshman once crossed the Ganges at this very spot using a jute rope. Today, the area is surrounded by several revered temples, including Trayambakeshwar Temple, Sachcha Akhileshwar Mahadev Temple, Lakshman Temple, and Shri Raghunath Ji Temple. Lakshman Jhula remains closed for visitors due to security reasons. However, the nearby Bajrang Setu, a modern glass bridge, offers a convenient alternative for crossing the river.

Distance from Hotel - 12.7 km | 40 minutes



Trayambakeshwar Temple



Located across the Lakshman Jhula on the banks of the Ganga, the 13-storey Trayambakeshwar Temple, also known as Tera Manzil Mandir, is a striking landmark dedicated to Lord Shiva. Designed in a pyramid style, it houses shrines of numerous Hindu gods and goddesses, with the main Shiva temple situated at the top. The structure is planned in a way that devotees encounter multiple shrines as they ascend, making the climb a spiritually enriching experience.

Distance from Hotel - 9.7 km | 29 minutes



Parmarth Niketan



Parmarth Niketan is a peaceful spiritual retreat situated on the holy banks of the Ganga, surrounded by the serene beauty of the Himalayas. It is the largest ashram in Rishikesh, welcoming thousands of pilgrims from around the world and offering a pure, calming atmosphere along with well-maintained gardens. With hundreds of rooms, it blends modern comforts with traditional spiritual simplicity. Located in Swargashram on the main road, it sits right beside the sacred Ganges River.

Distance from Hotel – 12.2 km | 40 minutes



Neelkanth Temple



As the name suggests, Neelkanth is closely associated with Lord Shiva. According to Hindu mythology, this is the sacred place where Shiva consumed the poison from the ocean and held it in his throat, turning it blue in colour, which is how the name Neelkanth came into being. The temple continues to attract a steady flow of devoted pilgrims who come to offer prayers to Mahadev.

Distance from Hotel - 11.4 km | 31 minutes



Rajaji National Park



Rajaji National Park is a tiger reserve and national park in India, covering the Shivalik ranges near the foothills of the Himalayas. Spread across 820 sq. km, it extends over three districts of Uttarakhand—Haridwar, Dehradun, and Pauri Garhwal. The park offers nature lovers a wonderful chance to explore its scenic landscapes and rich wildlife.

Distance from Hotel – 9.9 km | 30 minutes



Triveni Ghat



Pilgrims and tourists alike visit this ghat to take a holy dip in the sacred waters of the Ganges. Triveni Ghat, meaning the confluence of three, is one of the most popular and must-visit ghats in Rishikesh. The famous Ganga Aarti is held here every day, drawing a large number of devotees and visitors. It also serves as a starting point for boat rides on the river. Nearby lies Bharat Mandir, one of the oldest temples in Rishikesh, dedicated to Lord Rama's younger brother Bharat.

Distance from Hotel - 15.7km | 51 minutes



Beatles Ashram



A visit to The Beatles Ashram is a must when in Rishikesh. Now mostly in ruins, it remains a fascinating place to explore, even if you're not a fan of The Beatles. The ashram holds great historical significance, as visits by The Beatles and other well-known figures helped put Rishikesh on the global travel map and changed how the world viewed India as a spiritual destination a legacy that continues even today.

Distance from Hotel - 16.8 km | 47 minutes



White Sand Beach

Neergarh Waterfall



The jade-blue Neergarh Waterfall, also known as 'Neer Gaddu', radiates its stunning beauty as it tumbles down the rocky cliffs. During summers, many tourists visit the falls to bathe in the cool waters of the nearby stream. There are two small bridges across the waterfall, along with a few resting shops in the vicinity. A short trek leads you closer to this pristine natural attraction.

Distance from Hotel - 11.6 km | 37 minutes

Jumping Heights



Rishikesh is home to India's highest bungee jumping site, operated by experienced professionals. Known as the Adventure Capital of India along with being a major pilgrimage destination, it naturally attracts thrill-seekers from all over. The bungee jumping site is located in Mohanchatti and is operated by Jumpin Heights. Managed by ex-army officers with jump masters from New Zealand, it offers an 83-meter-high jump, making it one of the most thrilling experiences in the country.
