

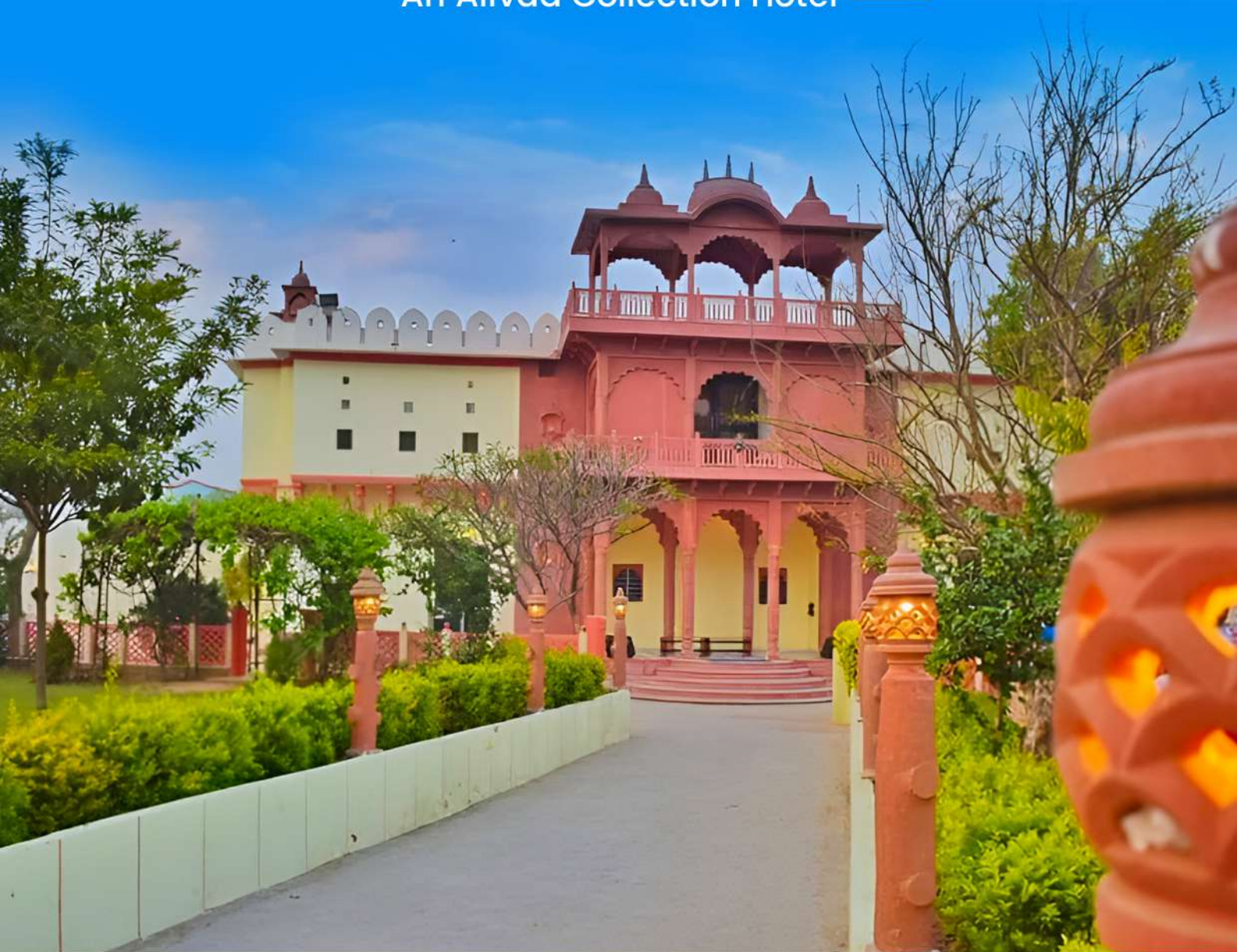

Built in the 17th century by **Thakur Ganga Singh Ji**, **Lotwara Fort** stands proudly in the peaceful village of Lotwara in Dausa—celebrated as Rajasthan’s “Peacock Town.” Nestled near the sacred Banganga River, believed to have sprung from Arjuna’s arrow in the Mahabharata, the fort is steeped in mythology and spiritual lore. Over the centuries, Lotwara Fort served as a symbol of Rajput valor and rural leadership, bearing witness to royal festivities, local revolts, and the ever-evolving spirit of Rajasthan.





OUR ACCOMMODATIONS

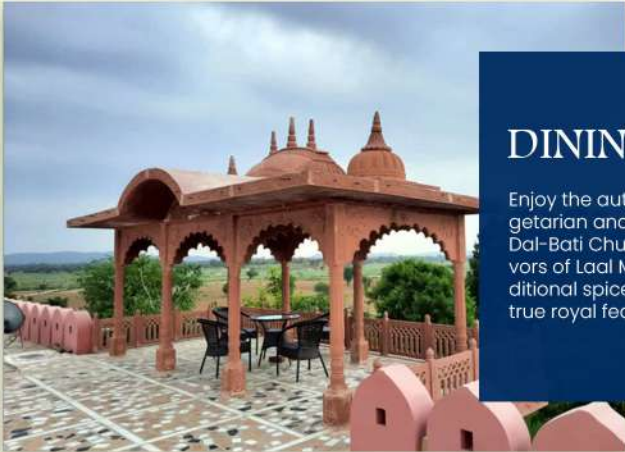

MADHUSHALA~THE BAR

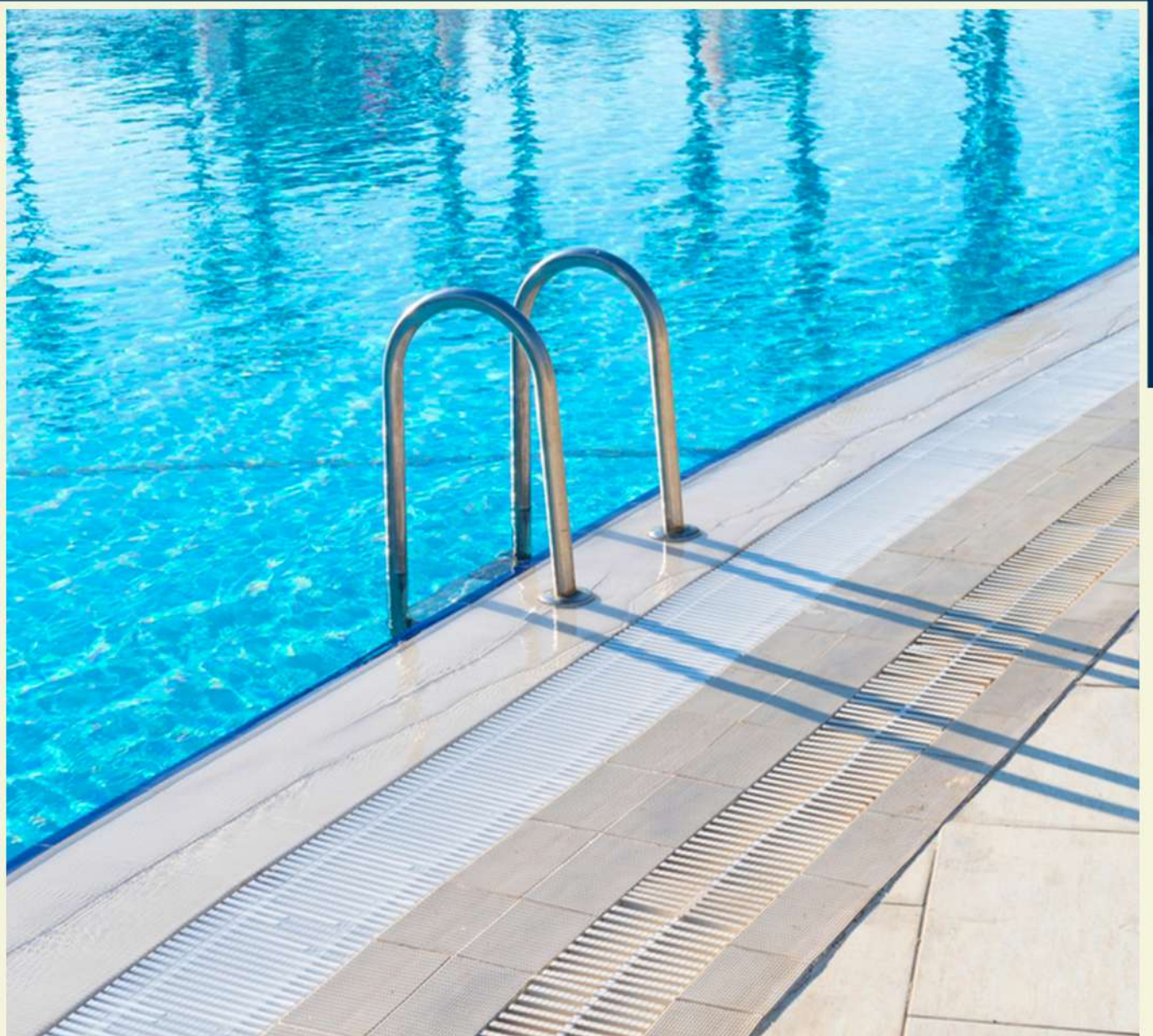

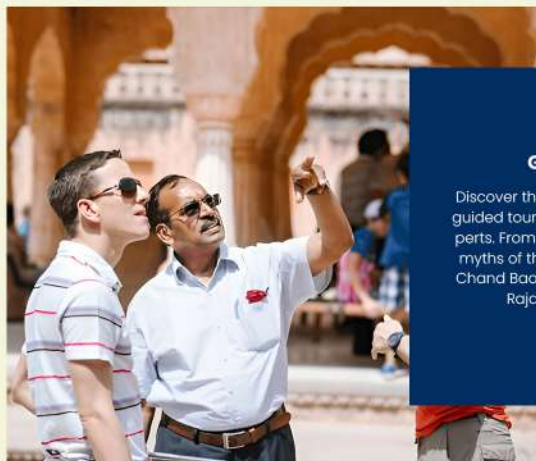
VILLAGE WALKS

GUIDED TOURS

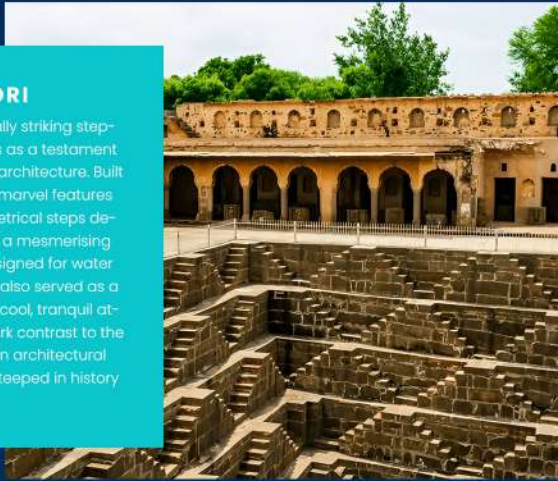

NEARBY ATTRACTIONS

CHAND BAORI

One of the oldest and most visually striking stepwells in India, Chand Baori stands as a testament to the ingenuity of ancient Indian architecture. Built over a thousand years ago, this marvel features more than 3,500 perfectly symmetrical steps descending over 13 levels, creating a mesmerising geometric pattern. Originally designed for water conservation in the arid region, it also served as a communal gathering space. The cool, tranquil atmosphere at the base offers a stark contrast to the desert heat, making it not just an architectural wonder, but also an experience steeped in history and purpose.



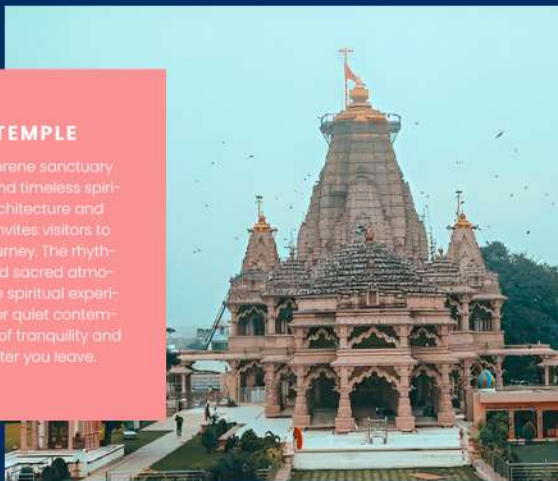
NAHARGARH FORT

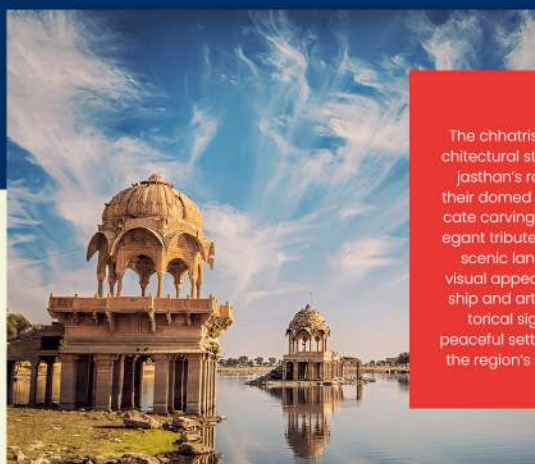
RADHA KRISHNA TEMPLE

CHHATRIS
